



SCHOOL INFORMATION FOR THE 2025/2026 SCHOOL YEAR

School Begins: Thursday, September 4th, 2025

School Ends: Friday, June 12th 2026

Minimum School Day Hours (every Friday) Kindergarten - 12th: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm

Extended Daycare Hours:

Morning: 6:00 am to 7:45 am

Afternoon: 2:15 pm to 6:00 pm (Fridays: 12:15 pm to 6:00 pm).

Requirements:

- Kindergarten students **must** be 5 years old by September 1, 2025.
- 1st-grade students must be 6 years old by September 1, 2025, and have a current physical exam.
- An adolescent whooping cough booster immunization (Tdap) is required for students entering 7th grade in September 2025. (New and returning students)
- A placement test will be scheduled for all new enrollees for Grades 1st – 12th. A \$40 (cash, card, or check) fee is due at the time of testing. **This fee is not part of registration. (non-refundable)**
- You will receive a phone call approximately one week after testing with placement results. You may continue the process below if the student is accepted into our school.

Early Registration Dates and Discount for the 2025/2026 school year. (Priority re-enrollment for current students only: 3/7/25-3/21/25) Early registration for everyone: Monday, March 24th, 2025. Registration: \$145 (Non-refundable) per student until April 11th, 2025. After Registration is \$210 per student **Dates are subject to change without prior notice.

Tuition and Fees for Grades K- 8th:

Option 1 – \$6,450.00/year or \$645/month for 10 months. The monthly payment plan allows for ten (10) equal monthly payments that cover the total amount of the tuition and are paid through auto-pay. Payments are due each month on the 10th. If the account remains unpaid by the 10th of each month, a late fee of \$50 will be charged to the student's account.

Option 2 – \$6,450.00/year or \$537.50/month for 12 months. The monthly payment plan allows for twelve (12) equal monthly payments that cover the total amount of the tuition and are paid through auto-pay. Payments are due each month on the 10th. If the account remains unpaid by the 10th of each month, a late fee of \$50 will be charged to the student's account. *(This option is only available if the student is registered by July 2025.)*

Tuition and Fees for Grades 9th- 12th Grade:

Option 1- \$7,300.00/year or \$730.00/month for 10 months. 2nd child-\$6,600.00/year or \$660.00/month for 10 months 3rd child \$5,280.00/year or \$528.00/month for 10 months

Option 2 – \$7,300.00/year or \$608.40/month for 12 months (This option is only available if the student is registered by July 2025)

E-Rate Survey This information remains confidential and will only be reported as a group (not by individual families) and only for the purpose of the E-rate program. It will be included in the enrollment process and must be turned in along with the Pastor Questionnaire.

Achievement Testing Fee - \$35: Grades 1st-8th only. (Administered every year)

The standardized tests by Terra Nova will not only show us where we can improve in our curriculum delivery, but it will also show parents how their children are doing compared to other children across the country. This applies to grades 1st through 8th. **It will be billed in September 2025**

Extended Daycare Fees/Hours: Extended daycare is available for K – 8th grade students from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. Daycare families are billed monthly: \$5.00 per hour for the first child and \$4.50 per hour for each additional child. Morning daycare is charged from 6:00 am to 7:45 am. Afternoon daycare hours for kindergarten are 2:15 pm to 6:00 pm, with charges beginning at 2:15 pm. Afternoon daycare hours for grades 1st – 8th is 3:15 pm to 6:00 pm, with charges beginning at 3:15 pm. *At 2:15 pm and 3:15 pm, all remaining students will automatically go into daycare. When a student is picked up from daycare, a parent or an adult designated by the parent on the authorization form must sign out the student in the Bright Wheel app. On the daycare iPad, using their own personal code. A photo ID may be required. Any student left after 6:00 pm will be charged a \$50 late fee per hour or any part of an hour. **Using daycare is a privilege, not a right. Students who are not respectful and/or obedient may be denied the privilege of daycare.** If you need to reach a caregiver before or after office hours, you may call (909) 744-0758. The daycare phone number will only be in service 6:00 am to 7:45 am, and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm. *Any student left from 6:00 pm - 6:15 pm, will be charged a \$50 late fee and a \$1.00 per minute thereafter. Students picked up late more than twice in a semester may result in losing daycare privileges for the remainder of the school year. This will be at the discretion of the administration.**

*** Minimum School Day Hours:** School will dismiss at noon. Extended daycare is provided in the mornings from 6:00 am to 7:45 am. Afternoon daycare hours are 12:15 pm to 6:00 pm. **Daycare will close at 2:00 pm on the following days:**

Back to School Night: Friday, September 26th, 2025

Christmas Program: Wednesday, December 17th, 2025

Open House: Friday, March 6th, 2026

Any student left after daycare hours will be charged a \$50 late fee per hour or any part of an hour.

Tuition: Failure to submit tuition payment by the end of day on the 10th of each month may result in the school withdrawing the student from all classes on the 11th until payment is made.

Check Policy: Your account will be charged \$50 for each check returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF). After two NSF checks, only cash, cashier's check, money order, and credit card (online through Gradelink) will be accepted for payment.

Food Services: Students must bring their lunch daily except Thursdays. Students have the option to participate in Pizza Thursdays for a nominal fee. 2 slices-\$ 4.50 3 slices \$ 5.25

Parent/Teacher Contact: Parents are encouraged to communicate with the school and/or their student's teacher as the need arises. Parents can write a note to the teacher, call the school office to arrange a conference, use the school's website, (ccrschool.com), or Gradelink account to contact a teacher by email. **Parents may not interrupt a class during school hours, but they may contact a student or teacher through the school office.**

Background check: Parents/guardians-There is a \$35 fee (tentative) for background checks. This is needed to go on field trips or helping out in the classrooms or events. **There are no exceptions. Cash, check or debit cards are accepted.**

Miscellaneous Fees: Parents should anticipate additional costs for special books, special instructional supplies, school yearbooks, field trips, student portraits, class pictures, graduation, emergency survival kits, hot lunch, and special events - i.e., music, culinary arts, drama productions, and assemblies.
